- 5. Old Business: R. Stephens raised an issue of inadequate classroom space for some of the Spring 2008 classes. Dean Butler commented that the College is making progress toward enrollment goals stated in the College's Strategic Plan, and the College will work to accommodate the growing classes.
- 6. New Business: J. Lee informed the faculty on the background and the current state of the Professionalism, Ethics, and Leadership Education Initiative (PELEEI). The faculty members have discussed this initiative as well as a number of related issues, including ethics in electronic communications, ethical aspects of the policies on cheating, development of students' presentation skills, etc.
